Attached you will find the accreditation regulations of the UÉ (Despacho Nº 11623/2016). Accreditation by each institution will be based upon and regulated by the UTAD-UÉ consortium agreement, which provides details of all aspects of the joint administrative measures necessary for the proper functioning of the Course. Accreditation of the programme in general will be based on common aspects of both universities' Regulations in this regard. Where total harmonisation is not feasible, the Regulations of UTAD (the promoting University) will prevail, with the exception of those relating to those optional curricular units (CUs) for which the UÉ has responsibility, in which case UÉ's Regulations will apply. For all other purposes, in the first (taught) year of each edition of the programme, the Regulations applicable will be the General Regulations of the host University. In the second and third years (i.e. those largely devoted to the research project), the general Regulations of the institution to which each student's principal supervisor belongs will be applied. The award of the PhD will be made by both institutions, under the terms of paragraph c) of Article 42 of Decree-Law 115/2013 of August 7.
